

MWRA Lead Loan Program Fundings

Marlborough

Distribution: \$1.0 Million

Private Side Incentive: 100% Community-Funded

Project is phase one of a multi-phased plan to remove all of the estimated 1,350 lead services in the City. Phase One is expected to remove approximately 100 to 300 full lead services. The City plans to borrow additional funds (up to \$1,000,000 per year for five years) to complete the entire replacement project.

Newton

Distribution: \$4.0 Million

Private Side Incentive: Private portion paid by homeowner via 10-year interest free loan from City

The project is a combination of inventory, design, and construction to remove all lead services in the City. Existing information will be reviewed to document/inventory potential lead services, bid documents for construction will be prepared, and approximately 584 potential lead services will be replaced following the award of the construction contract and consent by property owners.

Quincy

Distribution: \$1.5 Million

Private Side Incentive: 100% Community-Funded

The project will replace approximately 141 full and partial lead water services identified by the City, in both public and private property, as part of a city-wide lead water service line replacement project.

Winchester

Distribution: \$500,000

Private Side Incentive: First \$1,200 of private portion paid by Community, remainder paid by

homeowner

After a review of existing records and some outreach to homeowners by community staff to confirm information, the project will replace approximately 77 full lead services or lead goosenecks, and 29 partial lead services.
