B. Action Item: Approval of Advisory Board meeting minutes from April 20, 2023

David Manugian moved for the approval of the Advisory Board Meeting Minutes from April 20, 2023. John DeAmicis seconded the motion and it was added to the omnibus roll call vote for the end of the meeting.

C. Report of the Executive Director and Deputy Executive Director

Deputy Executive Director, Matt Romero, noted there that there would be an event honoring Mr. Favaloro's retirement on June 22 at Deer Island. Event details will be available on the website soon. He went on to note that language for Debt Service Assistance was only on the proposed Commonwealth house budget and not the senate. Staff will work with the legislature in attempt to include it the final budget. Advisory Board staff recently met with state legislators to discuss proposed Quabbin Watershed and Regional Equity Bill.

D. Action Item: AB Proposed FY24 Operating Budget

Deputy Executive Director, Matt Romero, presented the proposed FY24 Advisory Board Operating Budget, which totals \$499,953 (a 16.6% decrease from FY24).

E. Action Item: Proposed Comments and Recommendations on MWRA's Proposed FY24 Capital and Current Expense Budgets

Director of Finance, James Guiod, reviewed the Proposed Comments and Recommendations on MWRA's Proposed FY24 Capital and Current Expense Budgets. The combined proposed rate revenue requirement totaled 2.42%.
